Dear Mr. Taylor:

Please accept for your review and approval this Administrative Modification #19 to the Tahoe Metropolitan Planning Organizations (TMPO) 2008 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). TMPO staff is requesting a change for the attached project using delegated authority by the TMPO Executive Director to process administrative modifications to the FTIP. The modification falls in accordance with the procedures for FTIP Amendments & Administrative Modifications as approved by the Federal Highway Administration on November 17, 2008 and are within the same four year FTIP period. The proposed change is administrative in nature and will impact neither the regions air quality conformity nor the financial constraint of the FTIP.

This administrative modification reduces the total cost of the US 50 Cut Slope Improvement Project – NDOT identifier 2-05114 to \$6,000,000 for FY2009/10 and replaces the fund source with STP Statewide. Please see Attachment A for summary of changes.
