Dear Mr. Malfabon:

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) have reviewed the proposed TMPO Amendment #2 to the FY 2015-2018 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) transmitted in your February 9, 2015 letter. The Amendment is to add two new projects to the STIP, including Nevada Stateline to Stateline Bikeway Phase 3- Central Corridor Bikeway and Nevada SR 28 Corridor Management Plan Safety, Access and Operational Improvements Project Phase 1. The amendment also modifies WA20140058, Nevada Stateline to Stateline Phase 2. These changes are reflected in the attached STIP pages that were revised on February 19, 2015.

We have determined that the changes to the STIP do not require conformity determination. We find this STIP amendment was developed through a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with the statewide and metropolitan transportation planning provisions of 23 U.S.C. 134, 135, and 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53. Therefore, in accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding between the Federal Highway Administration, Nevada Division, and the Federal Transit Administration, Region IX, the FHWA's single signature constitutes FHWA and FTA's joint approval of Statewide Amendment #2 to the FY 2015-2017 STIP.
