Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

The Tahoe Metropolitan Planning Organization (TMPO), under the delegated authority provided by Caltrans to TMPO, approves Administrative Modification No. 4 to the 2017 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). This modification is consistent with the approved FTIP/FTIPS Administrative Modifications/Amendments Guidelines and Procedures and does not impact the region's air quality conformity or TMPO's financial constraint. The projects included in the modification are in alignment with the 2017 Regional Transportation Plan.

Staff has modified the projects using delegated authority by the Executive Director to process administrative modifications to the FTIP. Enclosed is the documentation for the following projects:

- 1. Grouped Projects Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities project:
 - Add four new projects:
 - 1. Lake Tahoe Blvd Class 1 Bike Trail
 - 2. Pioneer Trail Pedestrian Phase II
 - 3. Class I Bike Path: East San Bernardino West San Bernardino
 - 4. Incline Way Pedestrian Path (Nevada)
 - Update the existing funding for the Meyers Corridor Operational Improvement project; add Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds of \$3,451,000 to FFY 19/20
- 2. Grouped Projects for Operating Assistance to Transit:
 - Add FFY 17 Federal Transit Administration 5310 funds of \$80,000

TMPO certifies that the projects in this administrative modification are not included in any other amendment that is currently open for review. This administrative modification adds programming capacity in the amount of \$5,904,000 that relies on the State's federal programming capacity. The financial constraint information will be updated to reflect this administrative modification in the next amendment.

Under the delegated authority received from Caltrans, I approve this administrative modification to the Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP).
